2012 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

A deep red centre surrounded by a pink red hue.

Aromas of plum jam with hints of red and black berry fruits, freshly rubbed herbs and cedar.

Moderate in weight and length, with a juicy front to mid-palate and fine tannins finishing dry.
