

# HAMELIN BAY TASTING NOTES



## 2015 RAMPANT RED SHIRAZ CABERNET MALBEC

A pink red rim encircling a red centre.

Lifted red fruits, liquorice and blackberry characters,  
with spice, cocoa and cedar undertones.

Exhibiting elements of violets in the aromatic profile with  
savouriness on the finish. This wine has a generous mid-palate  
with long length of flavour and elegance.

Hamelin Bay's symbol is the heraldic beast called a wyvern,  
which is shown in full sway or rampant on this label.  
It suggests the wine has an exuberant spirit and lively character.
