

HAMELIN BAY TASTING NOTES



2013 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

A deep red centre surrounded by a pink red hue.

Syrupy cherry, smoked chocolate and nuances of dried herbs.

Sweet, juicy flavours with a moderate weight and assertive tannins giving a dry structured finish, urging for food. This wine will benefit from cellaring in the medium term.
