

HAMELIN BAY TASTING NOTES



2018 RAMPANT RED

SHIRAZ MALBEC MERLOT

Colour: Deep red with purple hues.

Bouquet: Raspberry and kola with rhubarb and black current leaf characters. Has an influence of sweet nutmeg and spicy oak finish.

Palette: Raspberries and leafy flavours fill the mid-palate with supple talc like tannins and a soft finish.

Hamelin Bay's symbol is the heraldic beast called a wyvern, which is shown in full sway or rampant on this label. It suggests the wine has an exuberant spirit and lively character.
