2019 RAMPANT RED

SHIRAZ CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Colour: Red with a purple hue.

Bouquet: Blackberry and candied raspberry with hints of smoke, char and toffee.

Palette: Medium weight and juicy. Raspberry and toffee flavours mingle with smoke and oak toast. Warm and easy going.

Hamelin Bay's symbol is the heraldic beast called a wyvern, which is shown in full sway or rampant on this label.

It suggests the wine has an exuberant spirit and lively character.
