

HAMELIN BAY TASTING NOTES



2020 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Colour: Red with a maroon hue.

Bouquet: black currant, red currant and black currant leaf with hints of mint and cedar. Gentle nuances of fennel and bay leaf mixed with subtle choc/mocha oak.

Palate: medium bodied with juicy red berry acidity and fine grained tannins. Black and Red currant fresh earth and cedar draw the palate to a fine persistent finish.

Cellaring will be rewarded.
